### Configuration & Features

#### ManagePro Standard

For the Individual or local, shared group LAN installation

#### ManagePro Plus

For the mobile worker or executive who needs 24/7 usage via a local copy of the db plus Web-based synchronization with the enterprise

#### ManagePro Smart

For the extended or dispersed enterprise, using a thin client & Internet connection to remote db

#### MProLite

Browser-based Lite version of ManagePro. Runs on PCs & Macs & interfaces with MPro Plus and Smart – not Standard

### CONFIGURATION

Installation of the program

ManagePro installation on the user's local drive/desktop is required. Connection to the internet is not required to access the database (unless accessing a WAN via VPN).

Program is installed on desktop. Connection to the internet is not required to access the database, however it is required to update or synchronize local copy of the db with the enterprise or web copy of the db.

A smart client version of the program is installed on the user's pc (the processing is done on the local pc, inter-facing with the desktop through a standard Windows interface). Connection to the internet/intranet is required to access db.

No program installation on the user's pc is required; however requires either MS Internet Explorer 7.0, Safari or Fire Fox as the operating browser. Connection to the internet is required to access the database.

MS SQL database installation and access. Microsoft SQL Express is installed by default, however user or user's organization may substitute Microsoft SQL 2005 as the preferred database

The database is either stored on user's local drive, or a LAN (Local Area Network) server if access information shared with others is required.

Database is installed on local drive and a Web-server. Synchronization between the local copy and the web server copy of the db requires MPro7-Link & ManagePro SQL db installation on a web-server (hosted by PST or user's org.). MPro7-Link is an ASP.NET service.

The ManagePro 7 SQL db is installed on a Windows 2003 Web Server to support users accessing the database directly via a secure web service, MPro7.net, an ASP.NET application hosted on the server to support the ManagePro Smart Client.

MProLite database (MS SQL) and PST's ASP.NET MPro-web application is required on a Windows 2003 Web Server to support users. Hosted by PST.
